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

Hang with the Airport winery experience:

Perhaps it's the cheap rent that has drawn many of Walla Walla's entrepreneurial winemakers to set up shop in some of the old buildings at the Walla Walla Airport (not to be confused with the new Walla Walla Regional Airport), creating a unique wine-touring destination. All the better for us, who get to revel in the funkiness of the old hangars and wander from winery to winery, finding favorites including **BUTY** (535 E Cessna Ave., Walla Walla; 509. 527.0901; butywinery.com), winemaker Caleb Foster's tiny boutique winery, which produces some of the region's most finessed and elegant wines. **MUST-TRY WINES:** * 2006 Conner Lee Vineyard Chardonnay (\$35)
